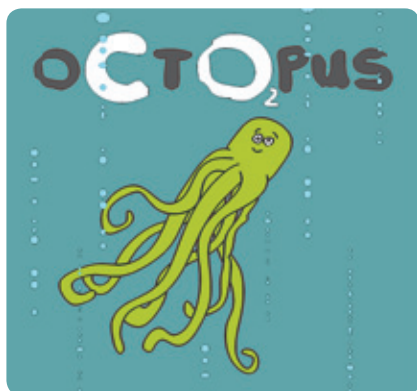


# \$50,000 Ocean Acidification Art Challenge

## Teacher Guidelines

Thank you for taking an interest in this major educational initiative. Here are a few easy steps to help ensure your school qualifies for the regional and hopefully state judging stages.

### Step 1

#### Registration of Interest & Art Challenge (Now Open)

- For full Art Challenge details go to the Entries Page at [www.OceanAcidification.net](http://www.OceanAcidification.net)
- Register your school's interest on Entries Page
- Download the Entry Form and read through the conditions thoroughly.
- Share the 8-minute curriculum-based video on the website Entries Page with students to gauge their interest.

### Step 2

#### Individual School Art Challenges (Now - July 2013)

- Create your own school art challenge following the selection criteria on the Entry Form.
- The second page of these Teacher Guidelines can also be used as an awareness poster.
- Select the winning piece of artwork and with your student complete the Entry Form. Please remember to also attach the student's own 100 word support submission.

### Step 3

#### Submissions to Regional Galleries (Open Seaweeek 3 March 2013. Final Deadline 3 July 2013)

- Submit the artwork, written submission and Entry Form to your nearest participating Regional Gallery. Details on the Entries Page.
- Each Regional Gallery panel will select 5 finalists and dispatch for State Judging.
- Your school will be notified in person if it makes the State Finals.

### Step 4

#### State Finalist Judging (15 July 2013)

- 40 Finalists will be selected from the Regional Gallery nominations.
- Finalists will also be posted online at [www.OceanAcidification.net](http://www.OceanAcidification.net)
- The 3 winners will be invited to VIP launch night.

### Step 5

#### Exhibition Launch & Prize Giving (12 August 2013)

- Prize giving at Federation Square.
- Exhibition 12-18 August, Federation Square.

### Step 6

#### Touring Exhibition Options (September onwards)

- Other venues are also being explored to give more schools the opportunity to view the Regional and State Finalists.
- Individual electronic images will be made available online for student educational projects.

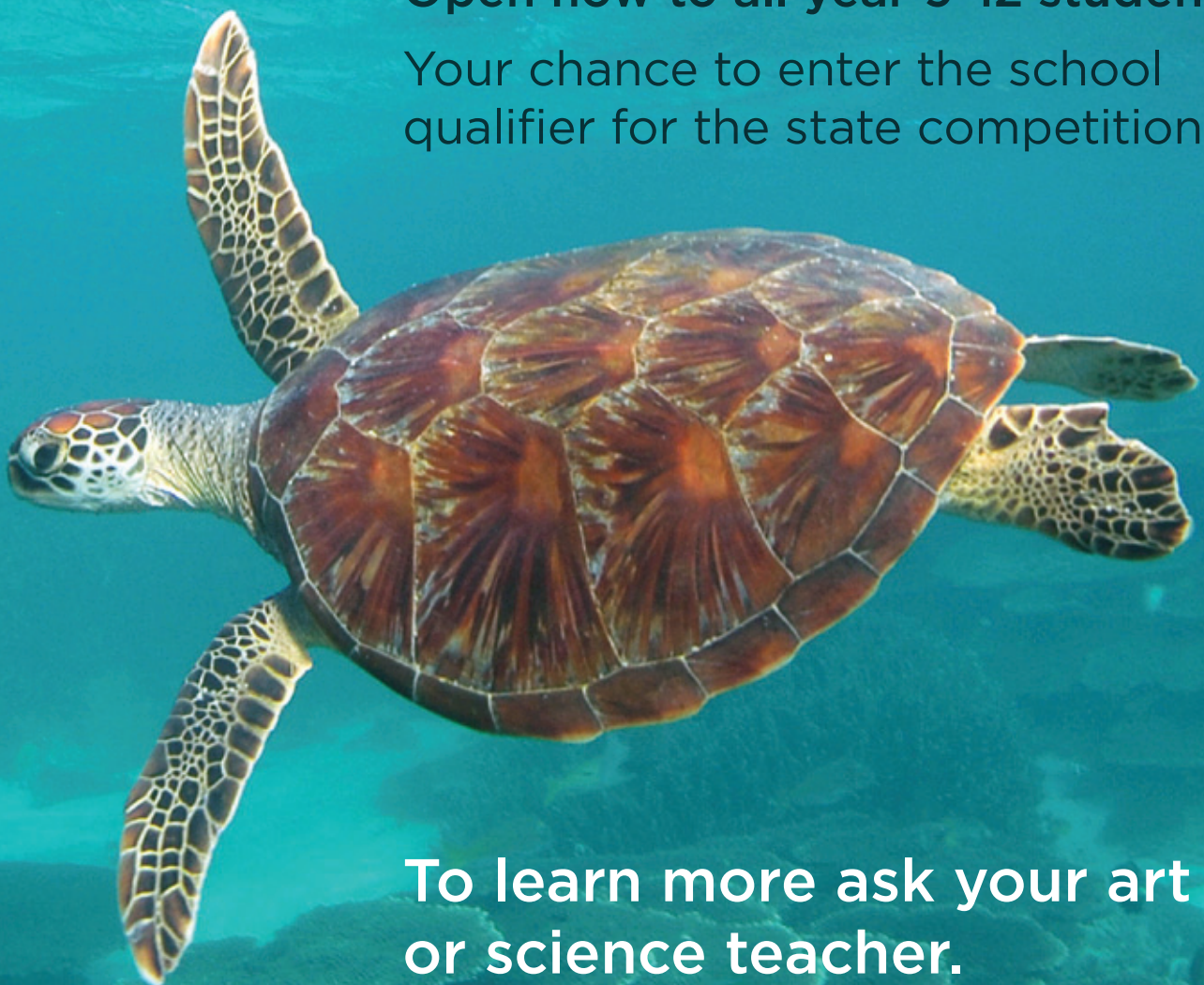
